1. Pray for our mission
2. Take an offering for Habitat
3. Provide a lunch for volunteers
4. Partner with other churches to sponsor a Habitat House build

6. Gather a group of 5-10 people from your church to volunteer for a half day or a full day at a build site
7. Volunteer at our Restore building in Moorhead - our construction thrift store
8. Invite us to speak to your church
9. Provide a bulletin insert about our ministry
10. Volunteer to drive our Restore Donation truck - help pick up donations.
11. Volunteer for our "deconstruction team" - remove cabinets to be resold in the Restore
12. Identify and provide families to partner with us and receive a home
13. Serve on our Faith Relations committee
14. Finally, Habitat International offers Global Mission trips within our own country and internationally. These are just beginning to reopen after closing during the pandemic.
