

## Criminal Status (Ability to Participate)

### Section A:

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Is applicant a registered sex offender? If no, continue to section B. If yes, the individual is not eligible to participate.

### Section B:

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Applicant convicted of a crime?
- Yes = 10 points
  - No = 0 points
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Age of applicant at time of commission of the crime
- a. 21 years or older = 15 points
  - b. 18-20 years = 10 points
  - c. 16-17 years = 5 points
  - d. <16 years = 0 points
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Time since most recent conviction
- a. Less than 2 years = 15 points
  - b. 3-5 years = 10 points
  - c. 6-10 years = 5 points
  - d. More than 10 years = 0 points
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Off probation/supervision?
- a. Yes = 0 points
  - b. No = 10 points
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Nature of highest offense
- a. Felony = 20 points
  - b. Gross misdemeanor = 15 points
  - c. Misdemeanor = 10 points
  - d. Petty misdemeanor = 5 points
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. More than one conviction?
- a. Yes = 10 points
  - b. No = 0 points
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Does the nature of the conviction relate to the nature, duties, and responsibilities of the position?
- a. Yes = 10 points
  - b. No = -10 points

### **TOTAL**

A total score of 70 or less qualifies the individual to participate. If individual obtains more than 70 points, they are not eligible to participate.

\*\*\*This point system is used as a guide, LAHFH hold the right to determine eligibility of an applicant.
